## Hot Spot Remedies from Club Members

GENTLY wipe the hot spot with a soft cool damp white cloth (pieces of old clean tshirts are perfect for this). Blot GENTLY with a soft dry white cloth. Spread a thin coat of an antibacterial cream (we used Neosporin) over the open sore with a QTip. Sprinkle a thin layer of Ammens powder or Gold Bond powder over the Neosporin (NOTE: Don't let the dog inhale the powder and keep the dog occupied for at least 5 minutes or so after you get the powder on – we always sat by our dog and also gave him a chewy treat to keep him from licking). The powder makes the spot quit burning and usually stops the licking. Don't do anything else to the spot. Don't wash the stuff off. If it works, the powder will just dry up on the hot spot and act like a bandage to help it heal. It will eventually dry up and fall off in pieces. BUT at the first sign of infection, hit the trail to your vet!

## Brytlea Dreams and Illusions (Jenny), 2/19/92 - 9/30/05

Jenny was my wife's heart dog. When my wife passed away a year and a half ago, I knew the day would come when she needed Jenny (and Jenny her) more than Jenny needed to stay here.

I accidentally left my cell phone in the room (I almost never do that) Friday morning in Gettysburg. I got the calls when I returned. Jenny had had two seizures earlier, about 6 weeks apart. Last Thursday evening she started again, having 5 during the night. She stopped waking up afterwards following the last one, and the vet came to get her following the call from my housesitter. Everyone waited for me to call in before doing anything, but it was clear to all the vets at the clinic that it was time. We made the decision about 5 CDT and she was put down before 6. She was cremated. I will spread the ashes over Betsie's because they both would have wanted that.

The housesitter suggested that it was providential that I left my phone at home so I could enjoy seeing Bree in Veterans. Maybe so. (She made the cut.) I know the decision to put Jenny down was the right one, though I will always regret not having been home for Jenny that day.

### The Rabies Challenge Fund

World-renowned vaccine research scientist and practicing veterinarian, Dr. W. Jean Dodds of California, and pet vaccine disclosure advocate, Kris L. Christine of Maine, have established The Rabies Challenge Fund to raise money to fund a 7 year canine rabies vaccine challenge study in the United States.

In addition to the challenge study, the fund will finance a study of the adjuvants used in veterinary rabies vaccines and establish a rabies vaccine adverse reaction reporting system.

Nationally, rabies vaccination is the one immunization required by law to be administered annually or triennially to domestic dogs and cats. Researchers believe this vaccine causes the most and worst adverse reactions in animals. The Rabies Challenge Fund has been founded to improve the safety of rabies vaccines and to determine, by challenge, if they confer immunity for 5 or 7 years.

The Rabies Challenge Fund's first official sponsors are Deb Odom (Florida) and Dawn Turner (Arizona), who have committed to donating a portion of the proceeds from the sale of their pet vaccine informed consent posters and informational flyers.
