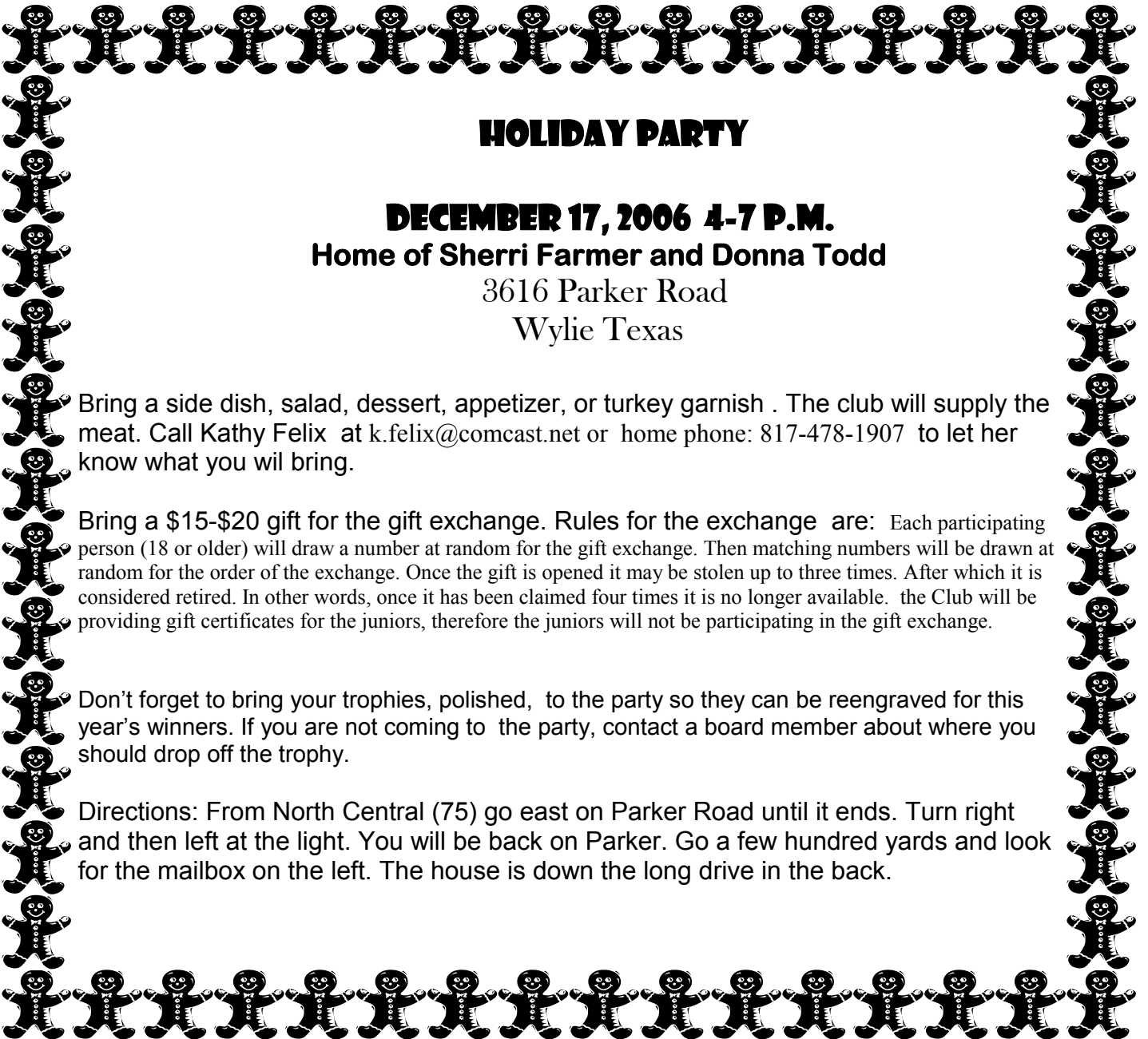

## JusCoz Goldens

My kennel name was derived from my first golden also.

He was my wonder boy, my introduction to the golden breed from conformation lines. I had owned two goldens previously to him, but they were purchased from a backyard breeder. They were wonderful pets, but they were in my life way before I knew dog sports existed, or conformation goldens especially.....

He was Cosmo. My heart dog.....my first time everything dog. Coz took a relatively inexperienced owner to places I never knew existed. He introduced me to some of my best friends to date and we learned together how to play all kinds of dog sports together.

We became JusCoz Goldens. Although I have only bred one litter, and Coz was the sire, I continue to use my kennel name on all my dogs since him as a way of keeping his memory alive for me.

We earned Cozs' CD, JH and WC all with very little training, but with a dog with strong natural instincts. Coz passed his WC at the first national to be held in St.Louis at Purina Farms.

Coz became a breed champion a year after I had shown him 52 times for just 2pts. The championship came 5 weeks later, after being out with a pro handler.

We did some specialing together in the breed ring, but never saw many rewards for that. Then at 9 years old, being retired from conformation, we earned his CDX. That year we attended the national in Florida, and made it down to the awarding of Best of Breed and Jams. We didnt get a Jam. The last Jam was awarded to the dog directly in front of us. But did we have a great time in the ring together that day.Cozy was the Best of Breed that day for me.

I lost my heart dog a year ago October 17th, 2005 at 12 and half years young. I miss him every day. Everyone should be as lucky as I was with their first Golden. Coz was

### **AKC ENDORSES THE “ANIMAL ENTERPRISE TERRORISM ACT”; ACTION EXPECTED IN CONGRESSIONAL “LAME DUCK” SESSION**

The AKC has endorsed S. 3880, the “Animal Enterprise Protection Act” (AETA). The bill was introduced by Sen. James Inhofe (R-OK) and principal co-sponsor Sen. Diane Feinstein (D-CA) in early September, and passed the Senate by unanimous consent on September 30, 2006 just before the election recess. It is expected to be taken up by the House of Representatives early in the post election “lame duck” session. The AKC is asking all fanciers to contact their U.S. Representative to urge them to support the AETA.
