GRCA HEALTH SURVEY

I hope you've heard that we are running a survey on Golden health issues. I have reported to the Golden Retriever Foundation Board in my note below that we only have slightly 600 dogs entered into our Golden health survey database. This data is an important snapshot of health issues related to our breed.

The survey can take 15 minutes up to one hour per dog depending on your internet connection speed and the complexity of the data related to a specific dog. If your dog was alive and well and you have a high speed connection, the survey will be completed quickly. If your dog has died or has suffered from a disease, make sure you have the best medical history possible before you start the survey.
