HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE JANUARY 2007 BOARD MEETING (AKC)

- The Judging Conflict of Interest Policy was amended, with the prohibition on AKC judges, judging non-AKC events removed. The full policy now reads:

Judging Conflict of Interest

“No AKC judge may have a significant interest in a dog registry or dog event-governing organization deemed by the AKC Board to be in competition with The American Kennel Club. Significant interest would include, but not be limited to ownership of, employment by, a directorship in, and holding office in.”

Central--no host club as yet
Eastern--no host club as yet.

Here's a brief history of GRCA's Regional Specialties: I've been going through past issues of the News in the '60's and '70's and you can see how these evolved. GRCA did the National and a Spring all-breed trial--the club was small, all centered in the upper midwest, and it was easy. Then Golden people in various parts of the country started getting together into regions. Soon these regions started hosting the National and the Spring trial, but still in GRCA's name. Then they started hosting Regional Specialties (did you know the 1970 Eastern Regional was cancelled because of student protests? Think Kent State.) But all of these were in GRCA's name and everything came through the GRCA Sec. AKC then became concerned about the number of events GRCA (and I assume other parent clubs) was hosting and requested/ demanded that the regions turn themselves into member clubs, apply for licensing in their own names and join GRCA as member clubs. So the New England Region turned into Yankee, etc. And as the number of Goldens increased so did the number of member clubs till we're now over 50.

Are Regionals something that our members no longer want and will no longer support? With the proliferation of all-breed shows, the increasing number of hunt tests and agility trials, and the fact that most if not all GRCA member clubs host their own independent specialties, perhaps Regional Specialties have outlived their usefulness. Please share your thoughts with us--we need your input!

Ed and Pat Gilbert's K9 Structure & Movement Seminar presented by the Lone Star Airedale Terrier Club

CLUB COMMITTEES

DFWMGRC's standing committees were established to advance the work of the Club in such matters as dog shows, field trials, obedience trials, trophies, annual prizes, membership and other areas which might be served by committees. The success of our Club depends on membership participation and every member is encouraged to join at least two committees. DFWMGRC's standing committees are as follows:

The **Bench Committee** assists the Specialty Chairman in planning our annual specialty, is responsible for holding one sanctioned show every year; maintaining a list of AKC licensed judges; rules for shows and matches; the breed standard; a current calendar of upcoming shows; and plans conformation activities throughout the year.

The **Field Committee** is responsible for holding one WC/WCX test and one AKC Hunting Test each year; maintaining a list of AKC qualified judges; rules for WC/WCX tests, hunting tests and field trials; a current calendar of upcoming tests; and plans field activities throughout the year.

The **Tracking Committee** is responsible for holding one sanctioned TD/TDX every year; maintains a list of AKC licensed tracking judges; rules for tracking tests; a current calendar of upcoming tests; and plans tracking activities throughout the year.

The **Obedience Committee** assists the Specialty Chairman in planning our annual specialty; is responsible for holding one sanctioned trial every year; maintaining a list of AKC licensed obedience judges; rules for trials and matches; a current calendar of upcoming trials; and plans obedience activities throughout the year.

The **Public Education Committee** is responsible for informing the public at large about interesting activities and events as they relate to Golden Retrievers. It maintains a list of city ordinances affecting animals in the metroplex and keeps the membership informed of any changes and updates.

The **Membership Committee** maintains and updates the membership list; prepares membership applications and new member information packets; introduces new applicants and members; maintains records of application dates and their status; and arranges a sponsor for each new member.

The **Hospitality Committee** arranges for refreshments at Club meetings and functions; works with the Conformation, Obedience, Tracking and Field committees to provide food and drink at Club events; plans the annual Christmas party and Awards Banquet.

The **Constitution and ByLaws Committee** annually reviews the Constitution and Bylaws and proposes appropriate changes of clarifications. It keeps a record of all Standing rules currently in force and is responsible for publication and distribution of the Constitution and Bylaws and the Standing Rules.

The **Puppy Referral Committee** answers questions about Golden Retrievers and refers callers to listed litters, stud dogs and kennels. It maintains the Club's weekly classified advertisement and responds to phone calls from interested parties regarding the Club, the GRCA and the selection and breeding of Golden Retrievers.

The **Web Committee** develops and monitors the club's web site.

Trophy Claims for 2007 and Onward

Having been the clubs Statistics Chair this year has been a real eye-opener, and quite a shock to the system. I have never met such a variety of means of submitting claims in my life, from formal letters to pencil notes scrawled on the back of envelopes. As many of you know I have been back and forth seeking clarification on this point and that for some weeks!!

So:
To assist all future Statisticians, and to aid the members at record keeping, I suggested to the Board that it might be a very good idea if we produced a form that covers all the details and asks all the relevant questions. They have approved the forms below and I am asking all members to use them in future.

The spread sheet should be easy to understand and, if you all fill it in after each win or score, then it will not present a mammoth task at the end of the year. It will also provide you with a clear record of where your dog is and what he or she has achieved, which will be fun to look back on in years to come.

There is a separate form for claiming plaques which doesn't need the spread sheet with it. Using these forms will mean the club has a clear and complete archive and will help to prevent confusion and disputes in years to come. *These forms will be in the October newsletter from now on.*
