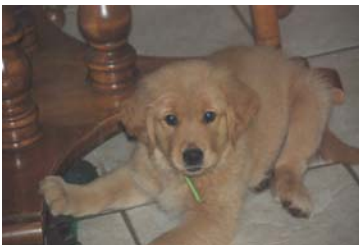

CLUB COMMITTEES

DFWMGRC's standing committees were established to advance the work of the Club in such matters as dog shows, field trials, obedience trials, trophies, annual prizes, membership and other areas which might be served by committees. The success of our Club depends on membership participation and every member is encouraged to join at least two committees. DFWMGRC's standing committees are as follows:

The **Bench Committee** assists the Specialty Chairman in planning our annual specialty, is responsible for holding one sanctioned show every year; maintaining a list of AKC licensed judges; rules for shows and matches; the breed standard; a current calendar of upcoming shows; and plans conformation activities throughout the year.

The **Field Committee** is responsible for holding one WC/WCX test and one AKC Hunting Test each year; maintaining a list of AKC qualified judges; rules for WC/WCX tests, hunting tests and field trials; a current calendar of upcoming tests; and plans field activities throughout the year.

The **Tracking Committee** is responsible for holding one sanctioned TD/TDX every year; maintains a list of AKC licensed tracking judges; rules for tracking tests; a current calendar of upcoming tests; and plans tracking activities throughout the year.

The **Obedience Committee** assists the Specialty Chairman in planning our annual specialty; is responsible for holding one sanctioned trial every year; maintaining a list of AKC licensed obedience judges; rules for trials and matches; a current calendar of upcoming trials; and plans obedience activities throughout the year.

Agility Committee arranges agility trials..

The **Public Education Committee** is responsible for informing the public at large about interesting activities and events as they relate to Goldens. It maintains a list of city ordinances affecting animals in the metroplex and keeps the membership informed of any changes and updates.

The **Membership Committee** maintains and updates the membership list; prepares membership applications and new member information packets; introduces new applicants and members; maintains records of application dates and their status; and arranges a sponsor for each new member.

The **Hospitality Committee** arranges for refreshments at Club meetings and functions; works with the Conformation, Obedience, Tracking and Field committees to provide food and drink at Club events; plans the annual Christmas party and Awards Banquet.

The **Constitution and ByLaws Committee** annually reviews the Constitution and Bylaws and proposes appropriate changes of clarifications. It keeps a record of all Standing rules currently in force and is responsible for publication and distribution of the Constitution and Bylaws and the Standing Rules.

The **Web Committee** develops and monitors the club's web site.

Banking Security Tidbit

Through the last couple of years I have had the opportunity to receive checks for an assortment of payments for the Club. Payments for Trophy Sponsors, club functions, etc... I have noticed several things on some of these checks that really bothers me.. being that I am a Personal Banker(for one of the Best Banks in Texas) I have to pass along the following tips. 1. Do not put your Drivers License # on your checks 2. Do not put your Social Security # on your checks I actually have seen many times both of these pieces of information on checks, mostly the Drivers License # It is actually advisable to only use your initials on your Check: A.B. Smith and some choose not to even put their address on their checks... All of this is perfectly acceptable... I actually have several customers that only use A B S. The less information on your checks the better if your checks are ever lost or stolen.. Another thing is that if you order your checks through another source besides your Bank, remember this... You are giving that company who in no way is as secure as your Bank your Routing # and your Account #. You may also think about having your Checks deliivered to your Bank the next time you reorder... It will be much safer than letting them sit in your mailbox all day.

NEW WC/WCX RULE

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board accept the recommendations of the WC/WCX Committee, and that the WC/WCX Rules and Regulations, Section entitled "AUTOMATIC ELIMINATION:

Number 2.Switching:" the following sentence be deleted: "Should the dog recover on his own, without handling or assistance, leave the area of the old fall and go to the area where the bird is down and retrieve that bird, it would not be considered an automatic failure."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that under the Section entitled "AUTOMATIC ELIMINATION:" the following sentence be added. 7. Returning to and systematically hunting the area of a marked fall which was previously retrieved.

The following are the rules to be followed now.

AUTOMATIC ELIMINATION:

1. Sending the dog before the judge calls his number.
2. Switching: a dog gives up his hunt after searching, leaves the area of the fall and goes for another bird, or when he drops the bird he is retrieving and goes for another. A switch is defined as a marking situation in which at least two birds have not been retrieved. A dog goes to one area, hunts but fails to find, leaves that area and goes to the second area where he does retrieve the bird. He has switched his hunt from one bird to another. A "switch" by this definition is an automatic failure. A dog that goes to the area of the fall of a bird that has been previously retrieved is not considered to have "switched"; he is hunting and old fall. DELETED: (Should the dog recover on his own, without handling or assistance, leave the area of the old fall and go to the area where the bird is down and retrieve that bird, it would not be considered an automatic failure.)
3. Recasting: definite refusal to go out for the retrieve.
4. Handling, as defined in the AKC rules for blind retrieves.
5. Manhandling the dog between retrieves.
6. Use of any device designed to prod the dog into action such as throwing something into the water or hollering from the field to get his attention.
7. A DOG THAT RETURNS TO AND SYSTEMATICALLY HUNTS THE AREA OF A MARKED FALL PREVIOUSLY RETRIEVED SHALL BE ELIMINATED. Amended 02/09
