## Directions to Cockleburr Acres

1. Take State Highway 78 north from Lavon past the intersection of State Highway 6 to the Copeville exit. The Copeville exit is 1.5 miles north of State Highway 6, and is marked as both Copeville and Business 78.
2. Take Business 78 north about 1.2 miles to the intersection of F.M. 1778. Take F.M. 1778 east.
3. Follow F.M. 1778 east for 2.1 miles to the intersection of County road 599. This will be the third road going north from F.M. 1778.
4. Follow County road 599 north for 1-1/2 miles to the intersection with County road 566. County road 599 ends at this point.
5. At Country road 566 turn right (east) and go a hundred yards to the intersection of County road 601. This will be the first road to the left after you turn onto 566.
6. Follow 601 north for approximately .5 miles. The gate is on the left near the top of the hill.
7. If you get to the intersection of County road 600, County road 603, or County road 605, you have gone too far.

**Easy way for a breeder to help rescue.....**

Have you always wanted to help with rescuing goldens, but didn't want to be involved with bringing possibly sick or unsocialized dogs into your home? Here is a way to help without every being exposed to any of the typical illnesses and heartaches associated with bringing dogs in.

This year has brought in an unusually large number of applicants to adopt rescues. We are looking for one or more people that would be willing to make one or more calls a week. This is our only screening process, so we need someone that is used to talking to people wanting dogs and can tell those that really want a companion from those that will put the dog in the back yard and forget it. Many breeders are experienced at this type of phone call. I usually spend 30 - 45 minutes per phone call. You can call from home, work, or at the dog show when you have a break between getting ready to show and dinner. We typically get about 15 applications a week, but lately we've been getting closer to 25, so could use some experienced help to get caught up. It's an easy job. You don't have to commit to making calls every week - make 2 or 3 one week, and then skip a week - it's whatever time you can fit in.
