

Minutes of Membership Meeting

November 15, 2010

The meeting began with a presentation by Cindy and Tracy from Patriot Paws. Memphis (Golden Retriever) and Roxie (black Lab) were present as well. After their presentation on the Patriot Paws program, the club presented them with a donation check for \$700 representing 10% of the proceeds of the raffle at the specialty and the heart and eye clinic to go towards training of service dogs.

Dick called the membership meeting to order at 8:00 pm. There were 16 members present, establishing a quorum. Dick mentioned that we have had a quorum for the last 11 straight meetings. The minutes were approved from the last meeting.

Committee Reports

Treasurer: Susan was absent; no report.

Corresponding Secretary: Linda Miller received a letter from Donna Todd asking for nominations for the GRCA board. Linda stated that she received a new check from Donna Allison for dues.

Unfinished Business

Dick asked for any new nominations from the floor for next year's board. There were no new nominations, so the slate proposed from the nominating committee will be installed at the annual meeting in January.

Dick announced that today (November 15) is the deadline for turning in statistics for plaque and trophy awards. Several members turned information in to Donna Todd.

The swap of trailers with the Lab Club is now complete. The reason was to make it more usable and update equipment. The initial trailer was bought from proceeds from the 1992 nationals. Our club is receiving a \$300.00 check from the Lab club for trading our larger trailer for their smaller trailer. There was discussion on present and needed equipment. The needed equipment to outfit the trailer will cost approximately \$4,000.00. After a discussion, a motion was made by Lesley Pettengill and seconded by Cathy Meddaugh for DFWMGRC to provide a budget of \$4,000.00 for hunt test equipment. Motion carried unanimously.

New Business:

Dick mentioned that Terry Thornton will bring to the board changes for Stud dog and Brood bitch trophies. Sherri stated that several trophies need revamping. Sherri also said that Anna Curry wants to change point values for field trials. Since Terry is the chair of the Bylaws committee, information should be forwarded to Terry Thornton.

Dick reported on an incident Carol Sandusky had. Animal Control paid her a visit responding to a false report that her dogs had been running loose. He further commented that in these times Animal Rights advocates may have great influence over animal control and may get AC to pursue responsible dog owners and breeders. He further commented that Responsible Pet Owners Alliance needs donations. Lesley Pettengill reported that she is on the Sachse City Council and the Sachse Animal Control Board. She encouraged all of us to become actively involved with our local governments regarding animal issues.

Barbara Brown asked Sylvia Donahey about why our Specialty Report has not been in the GRN-She replied that it would be in the next issue.

2013 National

Sherri reported that the search for a venue continues.

Texas Motor Speedway – Donna contacted them and was told that the infield is \$7,000 per day, plus the cost of tents. They don't have any suitable grassy area outside the stadium. All the land is rocky and very rough. After discussing our needs and suitable area with them, it was decided that this is not a viable option.

Southfork - The Samoyeds took the dates we requested. Southfork has never contacted us to discuss alternative dates. Sherri has reservations working with them, and she has reservations about having the National outdoors.

Meyers Park in McKinney – still viable but will have to obtain a weekend, perhaps buy Patty Drom’s weekend for 2013 only. There are 1500 parking spots, the cost for all of Myers Park, including the buildings is approximately \$6,600 for the week. We will have expenses for rental of generators for grooming and RV spaces. There are 225 horse stalls in the building across the parking lot, each with electricity. The site has not been ruled out depending on if we can get a weekend in October for the building to be available as a backup in case of inclement weather.

Amon Carter Ft Worth- David Reeves is checking on several issues and will get back to us. One issue is the availability of Watt Arena for Mon & Tues for the agility trial. The other issue is the anticipated completion date of 250 new RV spaces. There is a miniature horse show going on during the same timeframe. Presently there are only 85 RV spaces, which the miniature horse people use. David Reeves said the CVB is very easy to work with and have a lot of services to offer. All tracking areas, except for Erwin Park, are in Fort Worth. Field trials would be at the beginning of the week following conformation (Mon, Tues, Wed).

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:11

BREE

Bargello's Bree of Glengowan OD has just turned fourteen. She was whelped on Nov. 27, 1996, give or take a day. Her breeder Barbara Tinker was in the early stages of undiagnosed Alzheimer's disease and thus not real good about such details. Anyway the AKC has it as Nov. 27 so that's what it is.

Bree was a completely irrepressible puppy. She could NOT be contained in our yard, much preferring to go next door where there was a stable and she could munch on feces-encrusted hoof parings to her heart's content. :- (At least one a week I had to go drag her out of there. She also LOVED to chew flowers. My favorite memory of her first year was her utter destruction of a bed of tulips, which I only saw after the fact. The tulips were strewn about like straw and she was sitting there like a Spanish señorita with a tulip stem in her mouth, the flower out one side and most of the stem out the other. I have always regretted not having a camera at hand then.

She learned anything we would teach her almost instantly and I do regret not having ever done performance with her. She had a modest show career, which we abandoned about halfway through (9 points, 1 major) when it became apparent she would have a hard time staying in coat. She turned her attention to mothering, at which I have never seen a better bitch. She was truly in her element with her babies. Even after they were "weaned," and contained in a corral (a couple of ex-pens linked) in the kitchen, Bree would climb on the back of a nearby couch and jump in the corral to nurse.

She produced three champions, including Lynda Williams's Cagney who is a VCX and our Pepper (MIBISS GCh Glengowan's Sugar and Spice OD) who this year at nine has won two specialties and become the oldest golden GCh. Thirteen of Bree's fourteen offspring are still alive and healthy as far as I know, the oldest now being 10 1/2 and the youngest 7 1/2.

More recently, Bree has been the Queen Mother in our house, whom nothing really perturbs. She plays (but no longer with much enthusiasm) with all the puppies that the current girls produce, tolerating the puppies when they pester her, then woofing at them to get them in line when she is tired of taking it.

Bree sleeps a lot now and is a bit slow to get up, but she is healthy and happy. Once she is on her feet and trotting around you would never guess her age. Perhaps a bit deaf (or what some call "hard of listening"), vision impaired somewhat by cataracts, but none of that seems to bother her. I can't imagine the house without her and feel fortunate for the last fourteen years. Another two or three (or more) wouldn't hurt though.
