MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, MAY 21, 2012
SPRING CREEK BARBECUE, LBJ/PRESTON, DALLAS, TEXAS

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by President, Dick Caldwell. There was a quorum with 19 members in attendance. Teresa McKenna made a motion to approve the April membership meeting minutes as published in the newsletter. Sherri Farmer seconded.

In Shari Degan's absence, Sherri Farmer mentioned this was Barbara Lara's 3rd meeting and that we could take a vote on her membership. Donna Todd made the motion to accept her and Patti Caldwell seconded the motion. She was voted into the club by unanimous vote.

Patti introduced her guest, Jackie Woodall, who has a dog bred by the Caldwells. She has already been actively volunteering for the Club. This was her first meeting.

Lynda Williams gave the treasurer's report. She didn't have the final figures for the hunt test or the specialty (we have been waiting on our check from Onofrio), and is still working on the final figures for the agility trial, but she reported that we made \$650.36 from the agility raffle.

Before the selection of judges, there was a discussion about whether or not the Club should hold the July, 2013 specialty. Patti is chair of the July, 2012 specialty and she reported that the LSSC (Lone Star State Classic) has been extremely organized and easy to work with; however, several concerns were mentioned: We don't know what our income will be from the 2012 specialty, especially since it will be on a Thursday; a new point schedule is in effect now and Texas' region has the highest numbers in the country so people may not want to come here; Club members would be asked for more donations on top of the March Specialty, and we would be working on the 2013 National just 3 months away. Teresa asked if we could get back in the LSSC in 2014 if we skipped 2013 and Dick said that we could. Anna Curry made a motion that we do not hold the 2013 July Specialty. Judy Word seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. David Brown brought up the fact that we don't want to wait too long before selecting the judges for July, 2014, and it was suggested that sometime next fall would be a good time to do that.

The LSSC had asked Patti to ask the Club if we would be interested in participating in a December specialty. Since AKC only allows a club to hold 2 specialties a year, there was no more discussion about that possibility.

The selection of judges for our March, 2014 Specialty was next on the agenda. Judy Word and Cathy Meddaugh suggested names for both regular and sweeps classes. After voting by secret ballot the Club chose our first place choice as well as 2 alternates for the regular classes and sweeps. It was mentioned that our obedience judge was supposed to be selected by the obedience committee, so there was no Club vote on an obedience judge. Then Dick asked for a volunteer to be the show chair. No one volunteered, so Dick asked the Bench Committee to collect names and said we will try to get someone by June.

Sherri Farmer reminded the Club about the next meeting at Teresa's house where we will be able to look at various promotional merchandise and have input into what Teresa is considering offering for our 2013 National.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15.
