Left on Lakeview Pkwy (East on Hwy 66)
Cross over lake Ray Hubbard
Left on Fannin (still Hwy 66 east)
Right on Williams St (still Hwy 66 east)
Turn left on Hwy 1141 north
Cross over John King Blvd.
Drive approximately .7 miles. Turn left into driveway 2130 FM 1141

From I-30
Take the Goliad (Hwy 205 exit after crossing Lake Ray Hubbard. Stay on the frontage road past all the shopping centers till you get to John King Blvd. Turn left on John King. 2nd stop sign is FM 1141 (about 2 miles). Turn right on FM 1141. Go 3/4 mile to 2130 on your left. If you get to Tabor Lane, you just missed it.

From Highway 78
Go South on 205 to FM 552 (Tom Thumb shopping center). Left on FM 552 Dalton Rd. Turn right on FM 1141 drive approximately 1 mile. 2130 is on the right side of the road.
