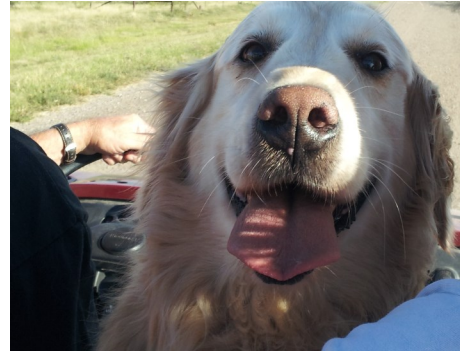

DFWMGRC Meeting- September 24, 2014 Spring Creek Barbeque, Irving, Texas

Meeting called to order by David Brown, President at 7:10 p.m. A quorum was established.

Treasurer's Report- Linda gave a brief treasurer's report

Corresponding Secretary Report - Kathy Felix unable to attend so Sheri Farmer reported that the AKC was requesting donations for the AKC Obedience Classic. A motion to donate \$120 for 4 photo plaques (trophyes) was made, seconded and approved unanimously. A prospective new member was present for her first meeting. She submitted an application for the club. Her name is Collette Savoie and she has an 8 week old puppy. She was introduced by Anne Burke at the meeting. Collette is interested in Conformation, Agility and Obedience.

March Specialty- The March Specialty needs Ring Stewards. In order to be a ring steward you cannot own or co-own a dog that will be shown. Patti Caldwell reported in Donna Stengel's absence that everything else is going well.

July 2015 Specialty- Three names were suggested to vote on as judges for the July 2015 Specialty: Dr. Penta, Bill Lauderdale, and Susan Foster. A vote was taken among the members present placing the candidates in the following order of preference: Dr. Penta, Bill Lauderdale and Susan Foster. Each candidate had more than 3 votes. Because of the urgency to get Dr. Penta under contract (since he's on the all-breed panel for the rest of the weekend and we were afraid some other club would contract with him), Linda Miller called Dr. Penta during the meeting to see if he was available. He would be willing to judge if his wife also received a judging assignment that day. There was some question and discussion regarding whether that is a feasible requirement. We decided since time is of the essence to hire a judge, Linda will contact Bill Lauderdale, our second choice, to see if he is available.

Sweepstakes judge- Patti Caldwell suggested Beth Lachnitt as a sweepstakes judge. She already is an AKC judge for the herding group and several non-sporting breeds, as well as a professional ring steward. She is interested in beginning to judge Golden Retrievers. A motion was made and unanimously approved to offer her that judging assignment. Linda Miller called her during the meeting and she accepted.

Agility- February 20, 21, and 22nd will be our Agility shows at Myers Park in McKinney, Texas. Sherri Farmer reported we have great judges and will be in need of volunteers to help with that event.

Hunt Test- Donna Todd reported that the Hunt Test and WC, WCX will be held on Oct. 25 and 26th, 2014 in Point, Texas. Volunteers are needed to assist both days. If interested in helping, please contact her. They are short of helpers since it conflicts with any members leaving for National.

Nominating Committee- Kathy Felix is the Chairman for the Nominating Committee this year. Three positions will be vacated: President, Recording Secretary, and Member at Large. Please give her any nominations.

2014 National- Kathy Felix will be making a basket to donate to the raffle and David and Barbara Brown will be taking it to National for the Club.

A motion was made to conclude the meeting at 7:50 p.m.
