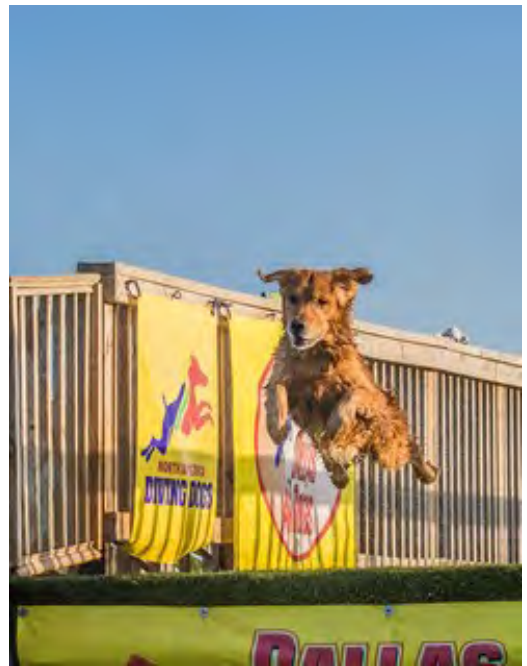

DFWMGRC MEMBERSHIP MEETING
JUNE 25, 2014
HOME OF KENDRA JOHNSON, PROSPER, TX

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Minutes of May meeting were approved as published in the newsletter.

Kathy Felix introduced a guest, Kristin Quigley. This was her first meeting.

Cathy Meddaugh mentioned that there would not be a July or August meeting, but she was planning on having an acupuncture talk at a future meeting and also a specialist in internal medicine whose emphasis is cancer diagnosis and treatment. Donna Todd suggested we rent the Midlothian Dock Diving facility for a meeting. She said a title could actually be earned while at the meeting. Donna said she would get in touch with the owner to get details.

Kathy Felix gave us the following names of the organizations that had sent us thank you notes for the donations the Club had made to them from the National proceeds: Golden Retriever Rescue of North Texas, Golden Retriever Foundation, NorCal for 2016 Specialty, RPOA (Responsible Pet Owners Association). David mentioned the very appreciative response he had received from the Morris Animal Foundation. They sent a thank you email, a thank you letter, and a package of information explaining their research and how to get more detailed, updated information when desired.

Linda Miller presented the treasury report and confirmed the Club's donation in memory of Barbara Lara's husband. David mentioned the death of Steve Thompson, the husband of club member and former club president, Kate Thompson. It was agreed to also donate \$100 in his memory to the Golden Retriever Rescue of North Texas. Donna Todd mentioned that she and Shari were now ready to close out the National Account.

Sherri Farmer informed us that the next agility trial is the last weekend in February at Myers Park and the hunt test is the last weekend in October in Bonham.

Patti Branch reported that the upcoming July specialty is ready to go, but has an entry of only 59 dogs, compared to 101 at the previous March specialty. There was a discussion as to why entries were down. Patti mentioned that Malinda Julien will be our photographer in July and she will be taking the pictures in her own setup with the props the Club provides. Patti reminded us about the decline of interest in the "judges' dinner" over the past few years, so we will not plan on doing that again. She said Barbara Shaw requested to meet with her, Dick and David after the Specialty for suggestions for next year. The Club had decided to choose our judge from the LSSC panel in order to save some money. This year, we chose the only judge from the panel that could also judge goldens, so one suggestion will be to let the golden people select a judge for them in 2015 that would also be a good draw for us. Then the question was raised whether or not we wanted to have the July, 2015 Specialty. There was a unanimous vote in favor of doing so. No one volunteered to be the Show Chair, so if anyone is interested they should email David or another board member to let them know.

David said our 2015 March Specialty Chair, Donna Stengel, has all deadlines met and that specialty is on track.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
